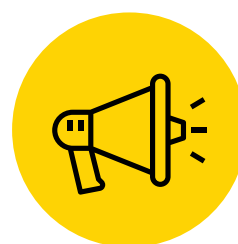

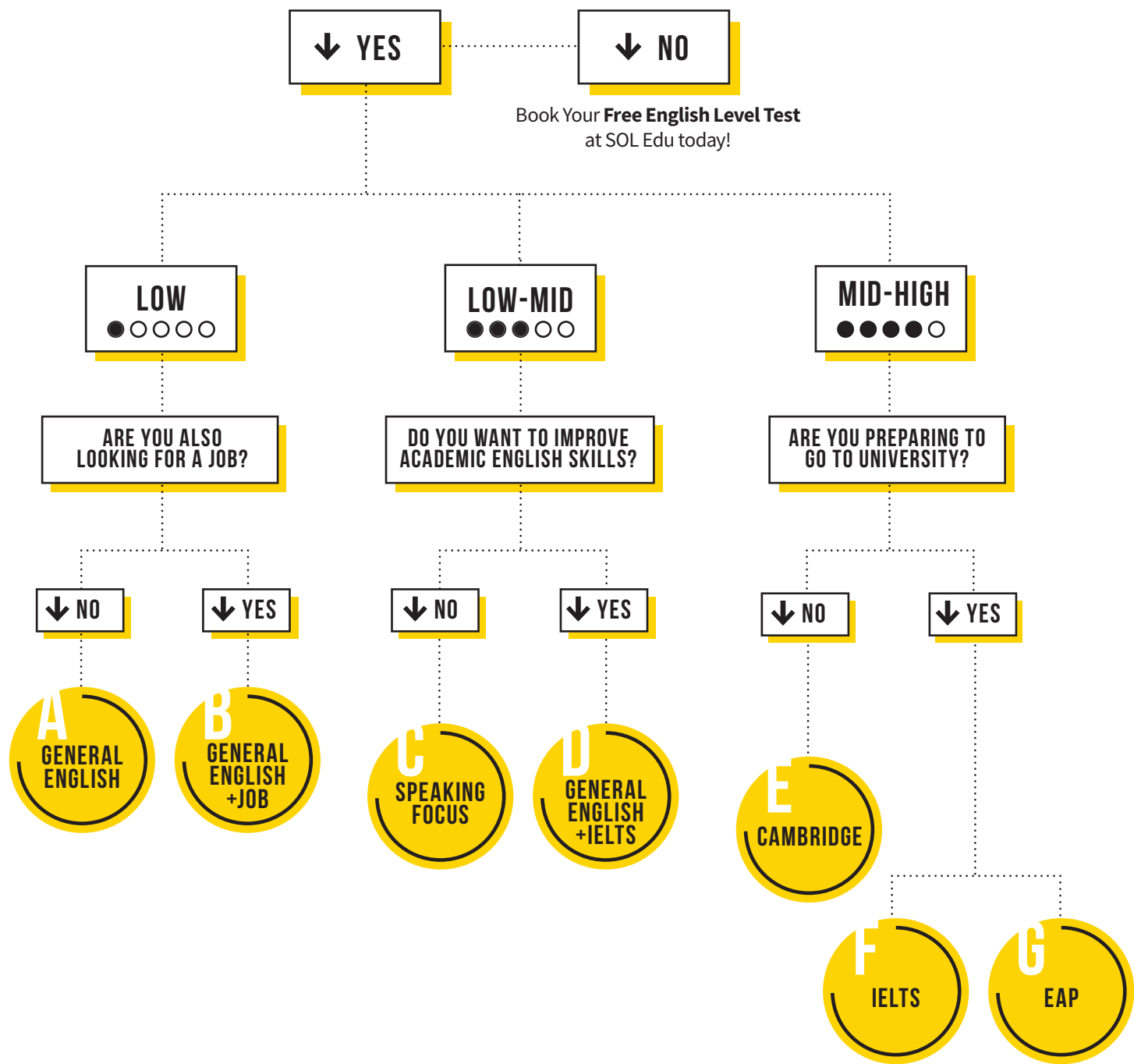

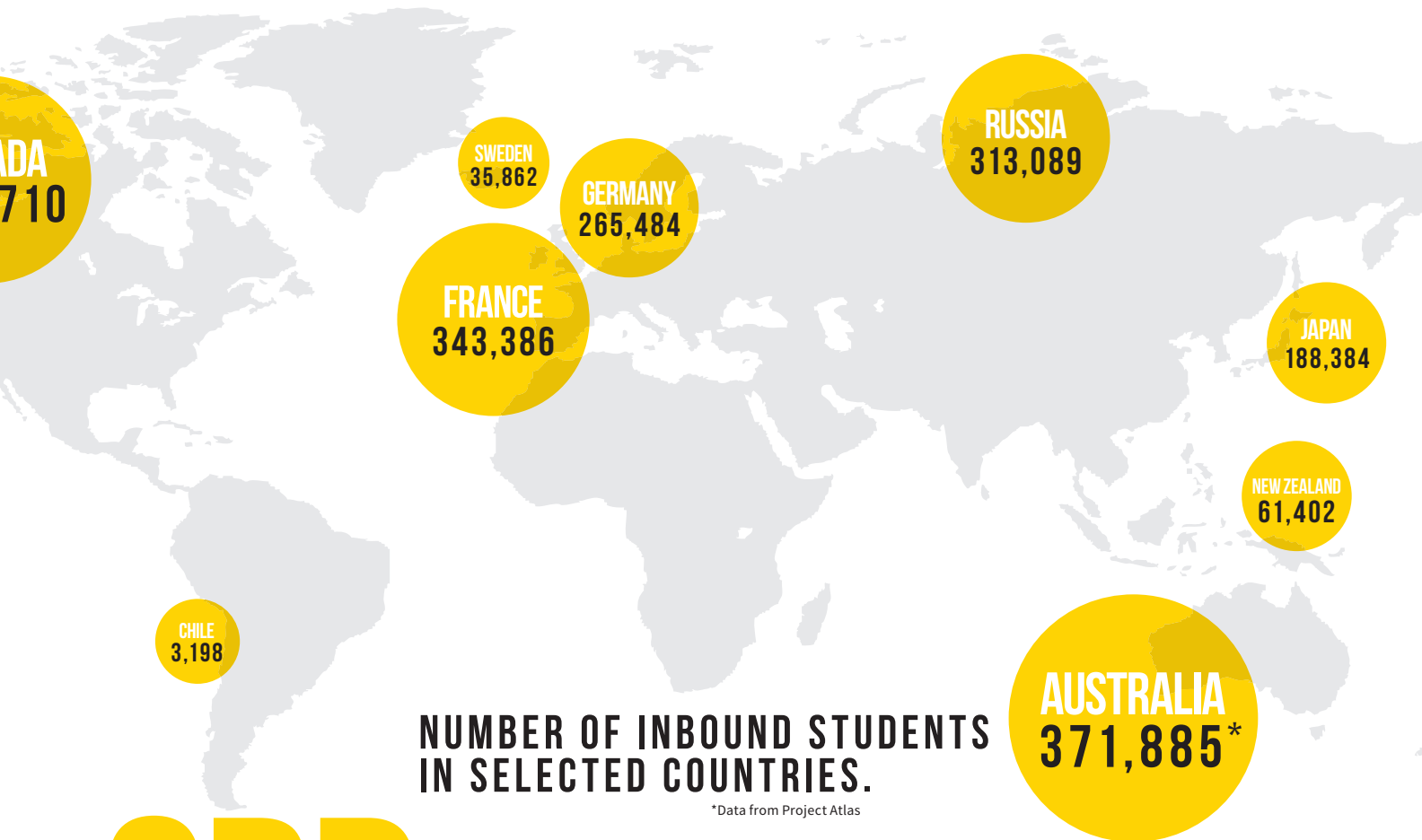

SKILLED MIGRANTS

This visa is for invited workers and New Zealand citizens with skills Australia needs, to live and work permanently anywhere in Australia.

02.

EMPLOYER SPONSORED VISA

This visa lets skilled workers, who are nominated by their employer, live and work in Australia permanently.

03.

PARTNER/FAMILY VISA

Allows the partner or spouse or family of an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident or eligible New Zealand citizen to live in Australia.

04.

INVESTOR VISA

This visa is for people who undertake business and investment activities in Australia. It allows you to stay in Australia indefinitely. To apply as a primary applicant, you must have a qualifying visa granted on a particular basis.

05.

PROTECTION VISA - REFUGEE

This visa is for people who are in Australia and want to apply for protection. It lets you stay in Australia permanently if you arrived on a valid visa, engage Australia's protection obligations and meet all other requirements.
